Who's involved

We are Motability Operations Ltd, a company authorised and regulated by the Financial Conduct Authority. All Motability Scheme vehicles are leased to customers by us.

Motability, the charity, oversees and sets policy for the Motability Scheme.

The Motability Scheme is better than ever

Since the start of your lease, we've been working to constantly improve the Scheme. Many of our familiar products are still available - some at lower prices than before. But we also have lots of new models that could be even better for you now. Our latest standard pricing starts from just £11.50 a week, with over 300 products to choose from.

Remember, you are eligible for the Motability Scheme if you receive:

Higher Rate Mobility Component of the Disability living Allowance

(currently £57.45 per week)

The Enhanced Rate of the Mobility Component of the Personal Independence Payment

(currently £57.45 per week)

War Pensioners' Mobility Supplement

(currently £64.15 per week)

Armed Forces Independence Payment

(Mobility element £57.45 per week)

Don't forget, only the person in receipt of the allowance can use the scooter or powered wheelchair. It should not be used, for example, by your partner or spouse.

You need to have at least 12 months remaining on your award to lease a product through the Motability Scheme. If you have less than 12 months remaining on your award, you can extend your current lease until you are re-awarded your allowance.

Payment is organised for you

As with your current lease, we arrange for the relevant amount of your allowance to be paid directly to us every four weeks. As most products still cost less than your weekly allowance, you will continue to receive the remainder directly from the Department for Work and Pensions or Veterans UK to spend however you choose.

A few changes to the Motability Scheme

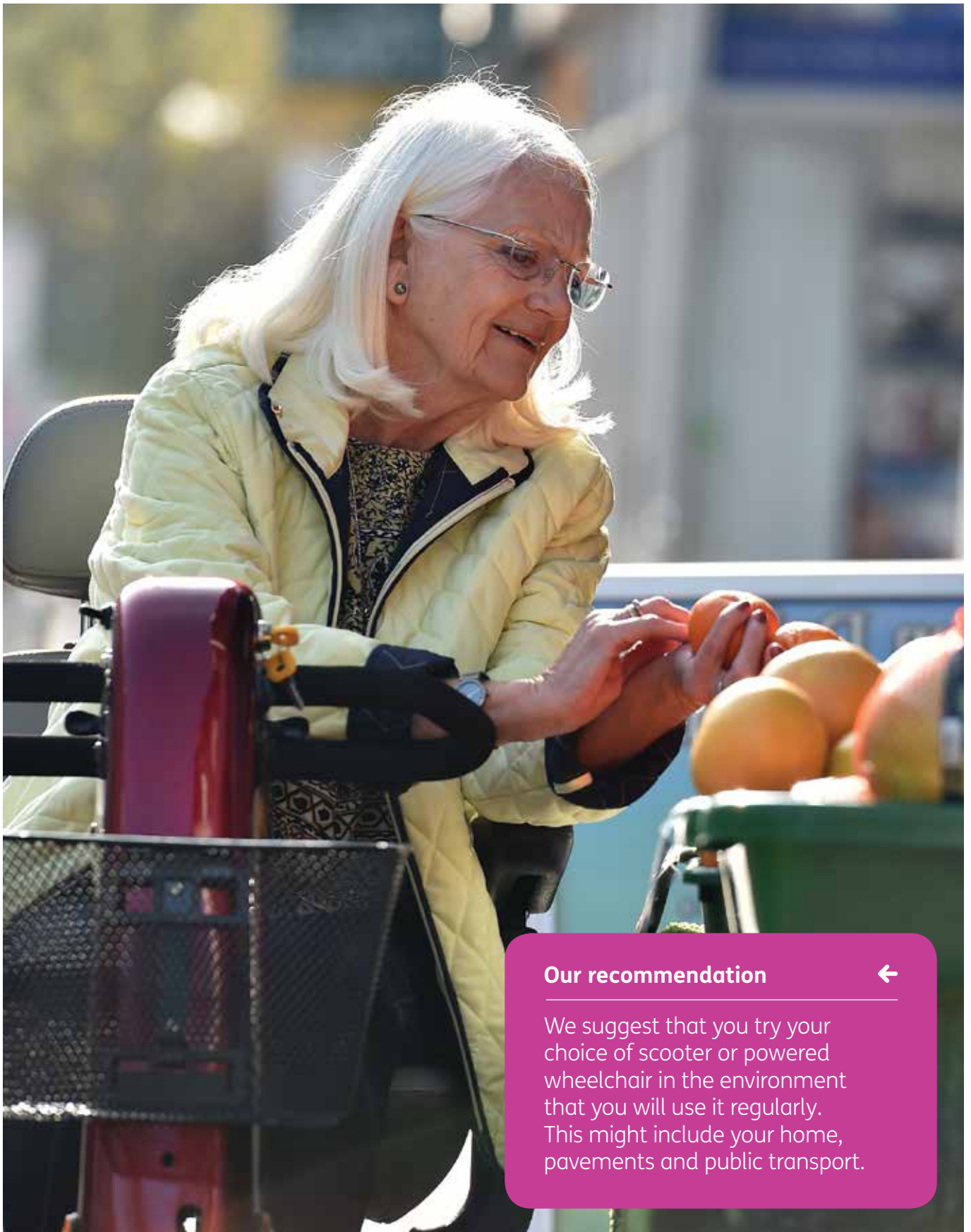
Since you ordered your current product, we've made a couple of changes to the Motability Scheme.

- 1.** We now ask that you make an up front £100 Non-refundable Payment to your dealer before you take delivery of your next scooter or powered wheelchair.
- 2.** We have introduced a £100 End of Contract Bonus, as a thank you for your custom. A cheque will be sent directly to you during the last few months of your lease.

Do you need something different now?



Your current product may still be right for you and your lifestyle. But it's worth considering other options, as there might be something new that better suits your needs. We have put together a quick reminder of the types of scooters and powered wheelchairs available through the Scheme, plus a few things to think about before visiting a dealer.

Scooters types

Small: Light, easy to transport but limited distance.

Medium: Carry more weight, sturdier, some are road legal.

Large: Bigger, road-legal, good for longer distances.

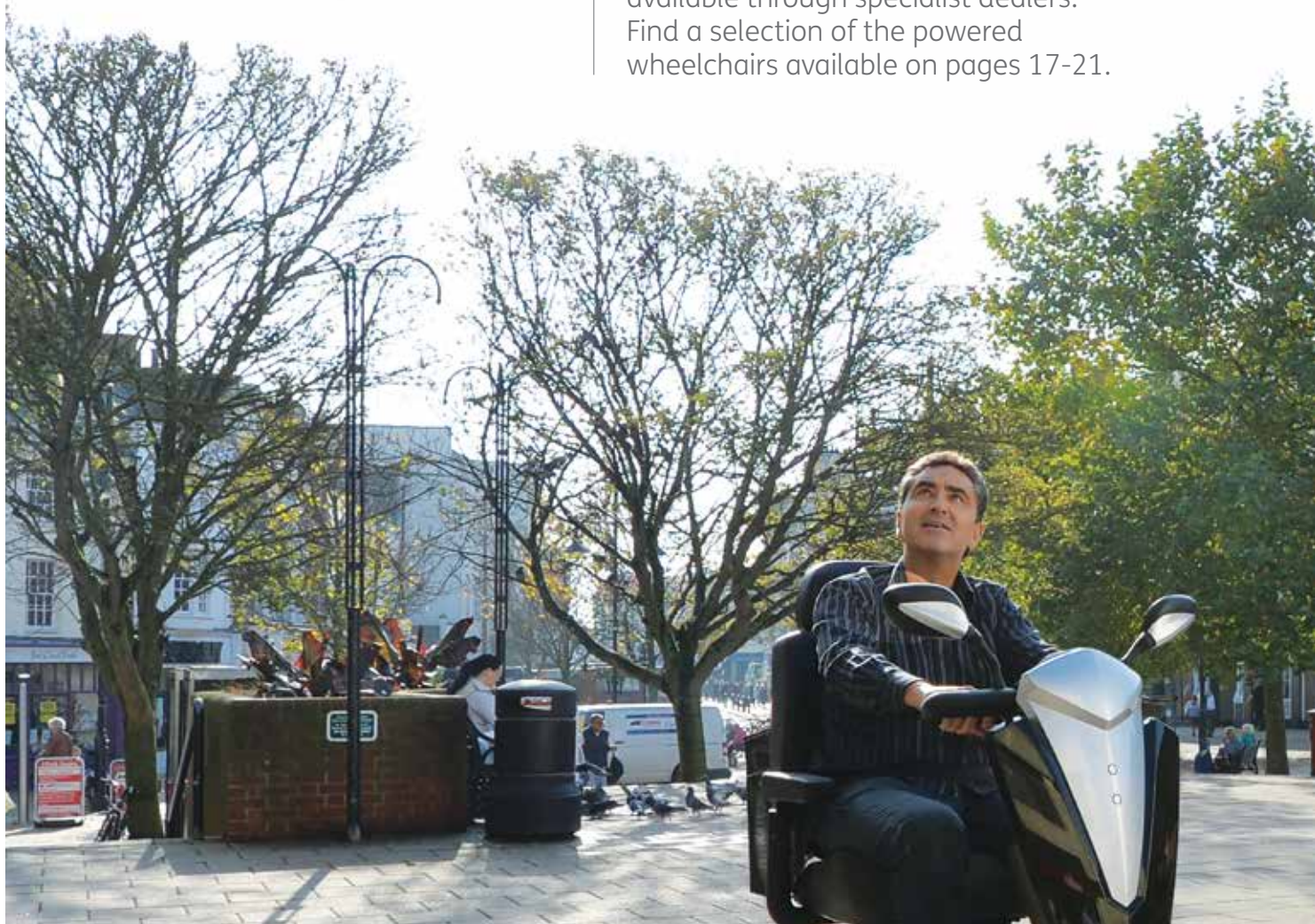
Powered wheelchairs types

Standard: Standard seats and controls, some can be folded for transport.

Standard Plus: Standard design but with the most popular adaptations fitted.

Custom Built: Tailored to your needs, available through specialist dealers.

Getting on and off your product

How have you found accessing your current product? Try different models to find out which ones feel most comfortable.

Need a little extra power?

Have you found that getting up hills can be a struggle on your current scooter, or your battery doesn't last as long as you might like? It might be worth looking at something with extra power this time.

Will you use your next product at home?

Perhaps consider something that's lighter with a tighter turning circle if you will be using it regularly around your house.

Making your trips more comfortable

Do you want to make long journeys on your new product? Think about the comfort of the seat, and how far it can travel on a fully charged battery.

Do you carry your product in your car?

Many smaller scooters can be dismantled or folded for transportation. You will need to test getting the scooter in and out of the vehicle if you wish to carry your product in a car.

Getting another powered wheelchair

If you have been using a standard powered wheelchair, your disability now might mean that you need to specify different features, such as the controls, or that you would benefit from a custom-built powered wheelchair. The dealer of your choice is ready to help

Even if your nearest dealer is some distance away, they will be able to visit you so that you can be confident that your chosen model is the best option for you.

Even if you are considering getting the same product again, it is important to remember that models can change over time, so always have a test drive to ensure that it is still the most suitable product for you and your lifestyle.

Insurance cover

You are covered in case of an accident, damage or theft, with no excess to pay. The insurance also covers you against any damage caused by your scooter or powered wheelchair to other products, property or people.



2. Tyre replacement

There is no need for you to worry about any punctures or damage to your tyres, as we will repair or replace them if there is a problem.

Battery replacement

Your scooter or powered wheelchair will come with a battery as standard so all you have to do is keep it charged. However, if anything goes wrong with the battery through normal every day use, it will be replaced, free of charge.

Our prices are negotiated and updated every three months so that we can provide you with the best offers from each manufacturer.

The prices in this brochure are for orders placed between 1 April – 30 June 2016. The price you agree with your dealer when you apply is the price you pay, even if it changes before you collect your product.

Since 1 January 2015 all of our standard products have required an up front Non-refundable Payment of £100 payable

to your dealer before you take delivery of your product. However, the majority of our products cost less than your weekly mobility allowance, which means you will receive the difference directly from the Department for Work and Pensions.

Price guide

How to use the pricing tables

1. Description

This gives you the range and model name.

2. Class

Class 2 products are limited to 4mph and are suitable for pavement use only. Class 3 products are able to travel up to 8mph, need to be taxed and can be used on some roads.

3. Non-refundable Payment

The non-refundable amount payable up front to your dealer before you take delivery of your product. This is in addition to your weekly mobility allowance.

4. Weekly Rental

The weekly amount of your higher rate mobility allowance that will be paid directly to Motability Operations Ltd every four weeks.

5. Number of wheels

The number and dimensions of a scooter's wheels and tyres has a direct effect on its stability and ability to tackle obstacles.

6. Speed in miles per hour (mph)

This is the maximum speed each model can travel at. All products capable of greater than 4mph will have controls that allow you to limit the speed to 4mph on pavements.

7. Weight Capacity

This is the maximum weight that the product is designed to safely carry.

8. Maximum range

This is the maximum range the product will travel once fully charged. This range is an estimation only and will vary by use, the type of ground, the weight carried by the product, the condition of the motor and the charge level of the battery. Make sure you take into account your return journeys.

9. Product weight

The weight of the product may have an impact on your ability to transport it.

SMALL – Boot scooters (Class 2, up to 4mph)

Usually dismantle into a few parts to allow you to stow it in a car boot. Make sure you try the scooter with the car you travel in most frequently to ensure it fits and that the person who needs to lift it is able to do so comfortably.

- Not suitable for use on the road
- Small, compact and lightweight
- Fold or dismantle for storage and/or transportation
- Can be used around the home
- Limited battery range
- Will carry less weight

MEDIUM – Midrange scooters (Class 2 and Class 3 up to 6mph)

Medium sized scooters are generally sturdier than smaller scooters, but are not as easy to fold or dismantle so may be more difficult to transport in a car (speak to your dealer to find out which models you can dismantle). Class 3, 6mph scooters in this section can be used on the road if they are taxed.

LARGE – ROAD LEGAL SCOOTERS (Class 3, up to 8mph)






Class 3 scooters are classified as road legal by the Department of Transport, meaning they require road tax (provided free of charge by the DVLA). They can travel up to 8mph on the road (4mph limit for pavements), and are suitable for longer distances and rougher surfaces.

STANDARD – Powered wheelchairs
