

Thank you for choosing the Motability Scheme; we hope you have enjoyed your current Wheelchair Accessible Vehicle (WAV). As you are approaching the last three months of your lease, you'll soon be able to order your next WAV on the Scheme.

This guide has been designed to help you through the final few months of your existing lease. It takes you through what to do next, reminds you of the things you need to think about when choosing a new vehicle on the Scheme, as well as a selection of the current prices.



Leasing your next WAV on the Scheme

A few important changes

Since you ordered your current vehicle, we have reviewed our policies to make sure we have clear and simple guidelines focused around the needs of the vast majority of our customers. There are just a few rules around who can drive your car, to make sure it's being used for the benefit of the customer:

- Only one named driver under 21 is permitted – this could be you, or another driver living at the same address.
- Named drivers should live within five miles of your address. We will, however, consider requests to include drivers outside of this range where this is essential to support your mobility needs.
- We may consider fitting a location tracker if none of your named drivers are resident at your address or you live in a care home where a number of drivers have access to the car. If we feel that fitting a tracker is appropriate then we will speak to you first to answer any questions you may have.

Financial help

For Scheme customers who would otherwise be unable to afford the type of vehicle they need, Motability, the charity, may be able to offer financial help. To ensure their limited funds go to those in most need, applications are means-tested and any help will only be given towards your basic mobility needs.





Support Payment for Accessibility

From 31 December 2015, we have introduced a Support Payment for all WAV customers to help with the costs of leasing your next vehicle.

This Support Payment recognises the additional costs of finding a vehicle suitable for your individual mobility needs and could be used towards the Advance Payment on your next WAV. If however you choose to leave the Scheme, you will still receive the Support Payment, which we hope will help with your on-going mobility requirements.

As you are approaching the end of your lease, you have become eligible for this Support Payment and a cheque will be sent out to you in the next 14 days.

The amount you will receive is based on the following:

- Customers with a five year agreement will receive £500
- Nearly New WAV customers with a three year agreement will receive £300
- Customers in a lease extension will receive £100 on the anniversary of each year of their lease extension.



Choosing your next WAV

We've put together a few reminders about things to consider when thinking about your next vehicle:

- ✔ Have your needs and requirements changed, and are they likely to change during the agreement?
- ✔ Is the size of your current WAV still suitable for the size and height of your wheelchair, or do you need a bigger WAV next time round?
- ✔ Have you been happy with the position of your wheelchair in your current vehicle, or do you think you might need to consider other options?
- ✔ Think about how you would like to access the vehicle, from the back or from the side? Do you still find your current access route suitable for you?
- ✔ When you have been out and about, have you found that some of the places you visit have been a challenge in your current WAV?
- ✔ Can you fit everything you need to travel with in your current WAV, including any luggage or equipment you regularly take out with you? If not, you may want to consider extra storage space in your next WAV.
- ✔ Would a Nearly New WAV on a three year lease be more suitable?

Once you've made a list of what you are looking for from your new vehicle, you'll need to contact some WAV suppliers. They'll help you try out the vehicles they think will be suitable for your needs. Test drives and demonstrations

Like before, our WAV suppliers will always provide you with a thorough test drive and demonstration of any vehicles you are interested in, to ensure that they are suitable for your needs.

The WAV suppliers are more than happy to talk through your needs on the phone first to build up a picture of the type of WAV which they think will meet your wants and needs. They will then arrange to bring vehicles they think may be right for you to your home for a demonstration. You should also think about any changes in the next five years which could affect the suitability of the vehicle before the end of the lease.

We've put together a list of our top tips, including things you should consider during a vehicle demonstration to help you decide whether a particular WAV meets your needs.

- ✓ Test drive more than one WAV, even if you think you may know what you want
- ✓ Take your time and don't be afraid to ask questions
- ✓ Ensure you are comfortable with the position of your wheelchair in the vehicle
- ✓ Involve the people you travel with regularly
- ✓ Check the WAV will be suitable for the places and roads you travel on
- ✓ Take all of your usual luggage and equipment to check there is enough storage space
- ✓ Consider fuel type and the cost of the fuel
- ✓ Practice getting in and out of the WAV, with the people who will be assisting you
- ✓ Check that you, and those who travel with you regularly, can safely secure the wheelchair in the vehicle using the tie-downs and seatbelts
- ✓ Ask your driver whether they are comfortable and confident driving the vehicle.

Countdown to your next WAV

3 months
to go



- Make sure your details are up to date with the DVLA and the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) or Veterans UK. We need all of the details to be current and to match for a new application to progress
- You must have at least 12 months remaining of one of the following awards:
 - ✓ Higher Rate Mobility Component of the Disability Living Allowance
 - ✓ Enhanced Rate of the Mobility Component of Personal Independence Payment
 - ✓ War Pensioners' Mobility Supplement
 - ✓ Armed Forces Independence Payment
- Place your order with the WAV supplier of your choice and tell them about anyone you wish to drive the WAV, including yourself. You will need to have the following with you to place an application:
 - ✓ Your driving licence if you wish to drive
 - ✓ Certificate of Entitlement from either the DWP or Veterans UK
 - ✓ Proof of address (for example a recent utility bill)
 - ✓ Nominated drivers' driving licence and consent (nominated drivers must give consent, either in person by being with you when you place your order, or by filling out the Driver Consent Form included with this guide)
- As part of the ordering process, you and your drivers will need to sign a Statement of Responsibilities. This document simply confirms that you understand and agree to abide by the Scheme rules around vehicle usage
- Inform your WAV supplier if you have a personalised number plate and wish to transfer it onto your new WAV.





2 months to go



- Your managing dealer should contact you to book your MOT test towards the end of your lease, but if this has not happened please contact your dealer as soon as possible. If you are interested in lease extending your vehicle, you will still need an MOT
- Look out for your new PIN – we'll send this to you along with all the information about your lease and Terms and Conditions. Your secure PIN enables you to 'sign' all paperwork, and you will need to make sure you have this kept safely, ready for the delivery of your WAV.



1 month to go



- If you have any adaptations you don't have to remove them, but if you want to, please arrange this with your local adaptations installer. You will need to pay for any costs involved in the removal of the adaptations
- Keep in contact with your WAV supplier about the delivery date
- Don't worry if there's a delay. Your WAV supplier will arrange for you to stay in your current vehicle until the new one is ready.



Delivery day



On the day your new WAV is delivered, don't forget to:

- ✓ Have a thorough demonstration of your new vehicle. Ask your WAV supplier to run through how each element of your new WAV works, making sure you are comfortable and confident with everything
- ✓ Hand your PIN to the WAV supplier as confirmation that you are happy with your new product
- ✓ If you are a named driver, you will need to show your driving licence to the WAV supplier
- ✓ Check that all drivers are included on your new insurance cover note.
- ✓ Make sure the WAV supplier has your correct contact details so they can get in touch with you during your lease with important information such as service reminders.

When you take delivery of your WAV, you'll also receive a Welcome Pack which includes all the information you need during your lease. Your Motability Scheme Handbook includes information on your insurance; what to do if you breakdown; the best way to arrange tyre repairs, as well as a recap on some important Scheme policies. The return of your current vehicle is normally arranged by the WAV supplier delivering your new WAV. If, however, they are unable to do this, please contact our Customer Services team on **0300 456 4566**, who will happily arrange a collection for you.

It is important to hand back any documentation and equipment from your current WAV when it is collected, such as the manufacturer's handbook and spare keys.

The WAV supplier or collection agent will complete a brief description of the WAV. Providing the WAV is in good condition, you could receive a Good Condition Bonus a few weeks later.




What WAV sizes means

WAVs will vary according to size and style, ranging from small to large – to help you consider what will suit your needs, we've included a size category on our WAV pricing pages. We've also provided an example of a seating layout for each different size of WAV to give you an idea of what's available.




Small

Smaller WAVs normally have a ramp rather than a lift to allow access. They usually have a lowered floor to give more headroom inside the vehicle and reduce the angle of the ramp making it easier to get in and out.



Medium

A medium WAV is more suitable for a larger wheelchair or if you need to carry equipment. Most will have a ramp but some are available with a lift instead.



Large

Large WAVs are a good option if you have a very large or heavy wheelchair or if you need to carry lots of equipment. They are normally fitted with a lift to make entry easier.

Wheelchair position

The wheelchair user will normally be positioned towards the rear of the vehicle. However some vehicles can be converted so that the wheelchair user can sit upfront next to the driver. It's important to remember that an upfront option will be more expensive. To see what vehicles are available just look for UFP in the vehicle description from **pages 13-16**.

- The terms, conditions, prices, model features and adaptations set out in this WAV price guide are correct at time of going to print. However, these may be subject to adjustment or withdrawal in the event of any changes taking place which affect the cost of the provision of the Contract Hire agreement or vehicle availability.
- The Contract Hire lease package with Motability Operations Ltd comes with a mileage allowance of 60,000 for three year leases and 100,000 for five year WAV agreements. If you go over this amount, you will be charged 5p for each extra mile.
- Insurance is included, however, in the event of a claim you will be asked to pay an excess unless a third party is found to be at fault. Full insurance details are included in the Insurance Cover Booklet supplied with the Motability WAV.
- Restrictions and higher excesses are applied to drivers aged under 25, speak to your dealer for more information.
- Metallic paint comes as standard.
- Motability Scheme customers living on the Isle of Man may be subject to an additional fee.

There are two main conversion types: you can transfer into a standard or adapted driver seat from your wheelchair or the vehicle can be driven directly from your wheelchair. Because these vehicles have additional bespoke adaptations to allow you to drive independently, they tend to have a higher Advance Payment than a passenger WAV.

Nearly New WAVs

Did you know that you can choose to lease either a new or Nearly New WAV on the Scheme.

Nearly New WAVs are a great option for those people who need a WAV quickly, or who need something more affordable. They are available on a three year lease and have a lower Advance Payment than the equivalent new WAV. It's important to remember that stock is limited and availability varies across each Motability WAV supplier.

A Nearly New WAV may be the right option for you if:

- ✓ There is one available that suits your needs; make sure the WAV you choose is suitable for you and your lifestyle
- ✓ You need to get a WAV quickly; if it's in stock your WAV supplier will be able to get your Nearly New WAV to you usually within a few weeks
- ✓ You need a WAV, but would like a lower Advance Payment; as long as it meets your needs, a Nearly New WAV offers the most affordable option
- ✓ You'd like a shorter lease length; a Nearly New WAV gives you the option to change your WAV after three years, rather than five.

If you're interested in this option you'll need to speak to your WAV supplier, and they can advise on the availability of Nearly New WAVs that are suitable for you and your needs.

Prices are based on 18 month old vehicles available on a three year lease for customers who receive either the Higher Rate Mobility Component of the Disability Living Allowance or the Enhanced Rate of the Mobility Component of Personal Independence Payment. Don't forget that all Nearly New WAVs are subject to availability.

Not renewing on the Scheme

Getting a new vehicle on the Motability Scheme might not be right for you at the moment. For example, if you've used the WAV less than you thought, consider whether it makes more sense for you to spend your allowance on other modes of transport, such as taxis. If this is the case, all you have to do is arrange a time for your WAV to be collected at the end of your contract. Simply contact your managing dealer and they will organise this for you. You will also need to contact the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP) to re-apply for your tax exemption certificate. Hopefully we'll be able to provide you with another WAV, car, scooter or powered wheelchair in the near future.
